



Workforce Housing Development Program

- Seeks funding to develop new rental projects for missing middle housing with an AMI of 80-115% AMI.
- Meets needs of workforce, families and seniors.
- City, HRA, EDA or County acts as applicant, may or may not be developer.
- Local expenditures and funds used for 1:2 match from MHFA.

Current Round: Due April 30

Next Round: Anticipated Fall 2025

Publicly Owned Housing Program

- Seeks funding to rehabilitate existing local governmentowned multi-family rental projects
- Addresses facility deficiencies for buildings serving lowincome tenants for the future

• City, HRA, PHA or County acts as applicant.

Upcoming 2024 Round: TBA



Manufactured Home Community Redevelopment Program

- Funds infrastructure improvements or the acquisition of manufactured home parks.
- Addresses the needs of aging manufactured home communities and prioritizes projects based on health, safety and critical need improvements.
- City as applicant.

Upcoming Round: Anticipated 2024

Community Homeownership Impact Fund

• Seeks funds to build new or purchase/rehab single-family homes for homeownership.

Works as a layer of funds into the home sale to reduce the

purchase price for lower-income households.

• Able to set AMI and qualify homebuyers.

Homes must meet visitability requirements.

• City or developer as applicant.

Current round: due July 11

Future rounds: annually in July



Local and Statewide Affordable Housing Aid

- Qualified uses:
 - ✓ Emergency rental assistance
 - ✓ Development of market rate residential rental properties
 - ✓ Developed or rehabilitated Workforce Housing
 - ✓ Creation or funding of Housing Trust Funds
 - ✓ Financial support to nonprofit affordable housing providers in

their mission to provide safe, dignified,

affordable & supportive housing

Local and Statewide Affordable Housing Aid (continued)

- ✓ Projects designed for the purpose of construction, acquisition, rehabilitation, demolition or removal of structures, construction financing, permanent financing, interest rate reduction, refinancing, and gap financing of housing to provide affordable housing to households that have incomes which do not exceed:
 - For homeownership projects, 115% of AMI
 - For rental housing projects, 80% of AMI

2023 Allocations: Received in December

2024 Allocations: Split between 2 payments

State Housing Tax Credit Program and Contribution Fund

- Incents taxpayers to invest in housing
- Investors for a state tax credit of 85% of your contribution!
- Investors can designate a project which can be awarded to cities, American Indian tribes, developers, PHA's and nonprofits
- Rolling application and credits delivered in 30 days which can be used towards their tax obligation over 10 years.
- \$9.9 million/year until funds are exhausted
